### ONE Day

1. 9:00 AM—Tour of the Emerald Triangle Cultural District in Uptown Greenwood
  - 9:00-9:30—Arts & Visitors Center
  - 9:30-9:45—Greenwood Community Theatre
  - 9:45-10:15—The Museum
2. 10:15-10:20 AM—Stroll down beautiful Oregon Avenue and arrive at sundance gallery
3. 10:20-10:40 AM—Tour the photography studio of jon o. holloway and sundance gallery
4. 10:40-11:00 AM—Walk next door and tour Meridian, 12 artist incubators and galleries
5. 11:00-11:30 AM—Stroll the streets of Uptown Greenwood and visit unique shops along the way.
6. 11:30-12:00 NOON—Enjoy lunch at one of Uptown Greenwood's eateries. Try Howard's on Main for a fresh deli sandwich, Polo's for a more intimate setting, T.W. Boon's for fresh American cuisine or Kicker's (Maxwell Ave.) for a little spice!
7. 1:00-1:15 PM—Restroom break/Drive to Emerald Farm
8. 1:15-2:00 PM—Tour of Emerald Farm, complete with animals, soap factory, hobby and antique shop
9. 2:00-2:15 PM—Drive to Park Seed Company
10. 2:15-3:00 PM—Tour the garden shop and the 9-acre trial gardens at Park Seed Company, the oldest and largest seed company in the world.

\*Please note—Motorcoach parking is available in the rear of the Arts and Visitors Center (Parking lot on Oregon Avenue), as well as Emerald Farm and Park Seed Co. Public restrooms and benches/seating are available at each site.
